- ❖ a farmers market of local produce only to be sold by the grower /maker. **No crafts**
- ❖ a market that is well advertised
- ❖ opportunity to meet and educate people as to the benefits of you local fresh produce
- ❖ a defined market area

What you will do

- ❖ grower/maker is the seller
- ❖ guarantee your produce is freshly harvested/made
- ❖ be committed to a weekly market
- ❖ pay a weekly fee \$30 or \$35 for powered site, after attending the market four times consecutively fifth is free
- ❖ adhere to *Food Hygiene Regulations for Stalls and Mobile Food Vendors* see Charter
- ❖ provide your own table, shelter, whatever you may need
