- Lyttelton Port of Christchurch (LPC) is the major sponsor of the photographic exhibition with support from the Diamond Harbour Camera Club
- Certificates awarded will include one gold, two silver and several bronze awards, highly commended and best under 20 year old photographer with one supreme winner chosen
- Winners will be announced at the opening event of the Lyttelton Summer Festival, 6pm Friday 19 February at Lyttelton Club, Dublin Street - **all exhibitors are invited to the opening event**
